- _ Surrogate mother will not be more then fourty five years

_According to the certainty it compulsory for couple to pay the rupies at the suitable time to the surrogate mother

_it is compulsory that this economic intercourse keep on paper Principles of study

_It's check that which caste, religion and age agegroup women are ready or want to became surrogate mother

_Check the surrogate mothers social and economic background

_Check the action and inter plays of among doctor and their family members

_Check the surrogate mother's role in society's continuous development

_Check the action of the surrogate mother, doctor, child the couple instead of them

When anyone couple is not given birth to their child because of any reason then they get child by surrogate mother. Take a woman's womb on a rent for a nine months and pay compensation to the woman who give birth to the child. 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_Thirty two answerable are for home and for children's future, thirty one answerable for to take their own possessive house and nineteen answerable are become surrogate for their children's future.

_Here eighty one surrogate have not information that the child whom they give birth why whose mother will not became impregnate.

_Answerables who give the birth to the child of couple in which percent couple are from out country in which America thirty, India nineteen, Lonfan seventeen and Australia's eighty percent proportion is showing.

_Ninety three answerable said that after birth child will hand over

_Here maximum answerable to become surrogate mother, most helpful is their life partner and it's proportion is eighty six percent

_Here sixty three answerable said that they will get two to two –fifty lakhs compensation to become surrogate mother; when seventeen get two- fifty one to three lakhs. This type of information is given.

For example live in surrogate house for nine months, take medicine, keep on corners. If during the child's birth operation will die doctor and opposite couple are not responsible for that. There is not a surrogate rights on child. If it will be miscarriage, couples are not bind to pay amount. From certain amount, not demanding mire amount from the couple.

_Main reason behind to become surrogate is women's poverty and economic need. For

_husband life's improvement and to teach the child female is ready to become surrogate. So here pull and push factors are showing.

_Here in child taking couple 70 percent proportion is from country to get the child by this method. In out country it is expensive when in India child is getting by surrogate with less expense. Out country's people are taking the profit of Indian woman's poverty.

_thus woman is give her womb as aren't only because of helpless poverty. Thus the poverty is the main reason to produce surrogate mother. When state miss the duty towards their citizen then citizen have use optional way to life Surrogate mother become surrogate for their poverty and economic need. Here she takes risk of life and she became other burn's conductor. This child is not her own, for some money give womb on a rent, it's all rights cut. Human have not get rights of live and security then he use optional way. Surrogate mother also hover over for live rights. Thus surrogate mother is breaking of rights.

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
